SETUP

1. Take your weaving board and bend the ends to loosen the notches on each end.
2. Using the white yarn, start in the bottom left hand corner of the board and insert the end of the yarn in the notch. Leave about 3 inches of string, the tail end, on the back.
3. Take the string and move upward and insert the yarn in the top notch on the left hand side of the board.
4. Wrap the yarn behind the board and into the second to left bottom notch.
5. Continue this method of wrapping the yarn and inserting it into both the top and bottom notches until you reach the last notch. Be sure that these are tight so that it doesn't have any slack.
6. At this point your end string should be on the back of your board. Stretch your yarn to reach the other end that we left at the beginning of our project. Tie both ends in a knot and cut off any excess string. You are ready to begin your project.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pull the end string out of your skein of colorful yarn.
2. Measure an arm spans worth of yarn and cut it.
3. Thread your yarn through the yarn needle and tie a knot to secure the yarn onto the needle.
4. Tuck the end of the yarn (not tied to the needle) into the bottom left-hand notch of your weaving board.
5. Insert straw under all white yarn on your board. This helps raise the strings up and will make it easier to complete the next step.
6. Now start weaving using an under-over pattern moving left to right until you reach the end of the board.
7. At the end of the row, you will need to "turn the corner" and move up to the next row. You will need to look at the last "stitch" you made and do the opposite stitch moving upward. (Example: if your last stitch was over, you will need to do an under stitch on the next row. Or if your last stitch was under you will need to do an over stitch.) If you do not do this, your previous stitches will come undone. BE SURE TO NOT PULL TOO TIGHT AS YOU TURN THE CORNER. This will cause your weaving piece to have an hour glass shape at the end.
8. After a few stitches into the next row you will need to "scrunch down" the previous row's stitches. You can use your fingers to do this. This ensures that your weave will be tight and stay together.
9. Continue this pattern until you reach the top of the board or whenever you like the size of your project.
10. To end the project, you will need to cut the white strings on the back of your weaving board.
11. Tie the white strings together either in one big knot on each side or you can tie 3-4 strings together in a knot to create an interesting design.

MATERIALS

8 feet - Dark Green Paracord
8 feet - Light Green Paracord
6 inches - Dark Green Paracord
Red Paracord
Scissors
Ruler

Tape (in OTHER bag)
Googly Eyes
Hot Glue
Pencil
Lighter (Parent use only)
Hot Glue Gun (Not included)

SETUP

1. Please know that this craft does include parent supervision and assistance as we will be using a lighter and a hot glue gun (both not included).
2. Plug in your hot glue gun.
3. Both dark and light green paracord is already cut to the size that you will need for this project.
4. Parents will need to fuse the 2 ends of your 8 inch dark and light green paracord using the lighter. You will simply hold one end of the paracord in the flame of the lighter until you see it start to melt. (CAUTION: IT IS VERY HOT!) Place one end of the other color of paracord in the melted portion of the other paracord while it is still hot. As it dries, they will fuse together.
5. Next you are going to attach your paracord to a pencil like you are attaching a luggage tag. Position the seam between the 2 colors off to one side.

INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

6. Tie both loose ends of paracord to something in your house that will hold it securely. The distance between where you tie it and the pencil should be 12 inches. If you go any longer than that, you will run out of paracord. Make sure that the dark green cord is on the left side when you tie the knot.
7. Start with the basic paracord knot, called the Cobra. Start with the dark green strand. Make an L shape. Then weave the light green strand under and up through the other side.
8. Pull both strands to tighten.
9. Now start with the light green strand and make an L shape. Weave the dark green strand under and up through the other side.
10. Pull both strands to tighten.
11. Now go to the right side (should be the dark green strand). This time go over the two center strands, then under and through. Pull the strand to tighten.
12. Repeat steps 7-11. You will start to see a pattern develop! Continue until you get almost all the way down to the pencil.
13. Remove the pencil and unfold the bottom loop. This will be the snake's head.
14. Take the small piece of dark green paracord and fold it over several times so that it fits where the snakes head should go. Put a piece of tape around it.
15. Set it inside the loop. This will bulk up the core for this part of the snake, making the head larger than the body.
16. Complete your snake using the Cobra knot as done before. (step 7-8) Be sure to alternate sides as you start each knot. Stop right before the end of the loop/head.
17. Cut off the extra paracord and have a parent burn the ends that stick out.
18. Use the hot glue gun to attach googly eyes to either side of your snake.

1. Set out your cups of paint and take off the lids..
2. Fill a cup with water to rinse your brush out.
3. Set out your plaster mold.
4. Grab your paint brush
5. Start Painting!!
6. Allow your painting to dry for about an hour.
7. Enjoy showing off your painting to your friends and family!

9. Wash out your brush with warm water in the sink.

GLITTER TUBE BRACELETS



MATERIALS

Large Tubing
Small Tubing Piece
Glitter
Scissors

Water
Clear Tape
Hand Sanitizer (Not included)
Perler Beads

SETUP & INSTRUCTIONS

1. Measure your wrist with the large tubing. You want it big enough that you will be able to slip off your bracelet, but not so big that it falls off.
2. Cut the large tubing with your scissors. Make sure the cut is straight.
3. The small tubing is already cut for you to the correct length. Stick the small tube into one end of the larger tube. This should be a pretty snug fit. Try to get it about half way into the larger tube.
4. Now you are ready to fill your bracelet with glitter, perler beads, and water. Be sure to cover the end of the bracelet end with your finger or all of your glitter will fall out.
5. Put the glitter in your bracelet first. You do not want it completely full or it will not move around when you put the water in. Next, you can put perler beads in your bracelet. This is completely optional. You will only need 4 or 5 beads to put in your bracelet.

INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

6. Now add water. The best way is to run your bracelet under the faucet. Make sure to turn the water on a low stream of water and cover the hole at the end of one end of your bracelet.
7. Still covering the hole on the end of your bracelet, squirt a small amount of hand sanitizer on the small tubing that is not yet in the bracelet. Immediately insert the small tube into the larger tube to create a circle. Shove them as close together as you possibly can.
8. The last step may require a helper. Tear off a small piece of clear tape. Then, pull together the 2 pieces of the larger tube so they are flush to each other. (You should not be able to see any of the small tubing at this point.) While holding the ends together, put the clear tape on to secure the ends together. This will ensure that the bracelet stays sealed.
9. Show off your bracelet to everyone you know!

1. Take clay out of baggie and set on paper plate..
2. Choose design on design sheets
3. Follow steps on design sheets to create your clay creation. You may need to use the toothpicks provided to create detail in your design.
4. Tip: Water helps smooth your clay out, but be careful not to use too much or it will make the clay too watery.
5. Let dry overnight.
6. Paint your creation using paint in cups and your paint brush.

KUMIHIMO



MATERIALS

Kumihimo Pattern
Embroidery Thread

Scissors
Tape

SETUP

Cut out the Kumihimo pattern out around the outer circle of the pattern.

1. Cut the slits on the pattern. Be sure to not cut too far into the pattern or it will be difficult to weave.
2. You will need 4 strands of embroidery thread, 2 of one color and 2 of another color. Measure each of them by stretching them out to be your arm span long.
3. Hold all of the strings at one end. Straighten them up to that the end is all even. The end that is hanging down, may not be even. Take your scissors and cut all of the strings so they are the same length.
4. Fold the strings in half, matching the ends so there is a loop at one end and 8 strings at the other.
5. Hold the string by the loop part of the strings and tie a loop knot.
6. Cut a hole in the center of the Kumihimo pattern with your scissors.
7. Make sure that the strings can snugly fit through the hole, so don't make it too big. Insert the loop down through the hole.
8. Separate the strings and insert your first color in the North (N) position on the pattern. Place the same color to the right of the N string. Then take the same color string and put it in the south position and one to the right of the S position. Do the same with you 4 remaining strings but put them in the East and West positions on the pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

10. Now we can start weaving.
11. Hold the pattern in your left hand. You will be moving the strings around your loom with your right hand.
12. Position the pattern so that the North (N) direction is at the top. Take the string that is in the North position (the one on the right) and move it down to the right of the same color at the bottom of the loom. Hook it in the loom.
13. Rotate the loom 90 degrees counterclockwise, so that East is at the top.
14. Take the other color (the string on the right) and move it down to the right of the same color at the bottom of the loom. Hook it in the loom.
15. At this point you should have 2 different shapes of string that look like brooms and 2 single strings. If you do not have this, go back and try the steps again.
16. Rotate the loom 90 degrees counterclockwise. Choose the string that is most on the right of that color, and move it to the bottom right of the color on the loom.
17. Repeat these steps until you are close to running out of string.
18. To tie off your bracelet, pull the bracelet out of the loom. Tie a loop knot on the loose end.
19. You can reuse your loom as many times as you want!

HYDRODIPPING



MATERIALS

Water bottle	Modge Podge
Tape	Paint Brush
Marbling Paints	Plastic Gloves
Plastic Tub	Cardboard Piece
Skewer	

SETUP

1. Be sure you are in a well ventilated area or outside.
2. Read directions all the way through once and then start on your project.
3. Fill the plastic tub 2/3 of the way full with water.
4. Tape lid of water bottle and where your mouth will touch the water bottle. Be sure that your tape around the edge is straight or your design will look off.
5. Put on gloves.
6. Choose colors of the marbling paints that you would like to use and set them out. You can take off the lids and set next to the tub so they are ready to use.
7. Have your cardboard piece and skewer next to the tub as well.
8. Starting with the darkest color first, shake your marbling paints on top of the water. THE PAINT DRIES FAST SO BE READY TO MOVE!!!! Shake your other colors on top of the water as well using an alternating pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

9. Use the Skewer and marble the paint using a swivel motion. (like you are drawing a snake in the water).
10. Quickly grab your water bottle. Be sure to hold it by the taped lid and insert the water bottle in the water slowly at a 45 degree angle until all of the bottle is underwater.
11. Shake the bottle underwater back and forth to loosen any extra paint hanging around your bottle.
12. Use the skewer to move excess paint out of the way and bring your bottle out of the water.
13. The paint dries quickly, but set bottle aside for 5 minutes.
14. Clear off the paint that is on the top of the water using your cardboard piece and bring it to the sides.
15. Take off gloves.
16. Get Modge Podge and paint brush and paint the outside of your bottle. This protects it so that the bottle can be washed in the dishwasher. Let dry completely.
17. Dump water down drain or outside. Throw away skewer, gloves, cardboard, and tape.
18. Enjoy!

SETUP & INSTRUCTIONS

1. Set up your canvas on a flat work space.
2. Fill your cup with water to rinse your brush out in.
3. Open all of the paint cups. Put some white paint on the paper plate.
4. Wet your brush and dab it on a paper towel
5. Dip your brush in the blue paint and brush a little on the plate as a test. Then at the top of your canvas using an arc motion apply a thin layer of the blue paint. Continue doing this until you are about half way down the sky portion of your painting.
6. Add a second layer of paint over what you just painted. Paint the sides as well.
7. While the blue paint is still wet, dip your brush in the white paint (don't wash out your brush) and start making an arc motion under where you already painted the dark blue paint.
8. As you move down the painting, apply more white paint to create a lighter blue colored sky on your canvas. Stop once you reach the line that separates your sky from your ground.
9. Paint your sides with the light blue color.

INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

9. Paint the bottom portion of the canvas solid black. Paint the sides.
10. Using the black paint, paint the trees. Start on the left side of the tree line. Start at the top of the tree and create a triangle shape with your brush. Keep working down the tree, being sure to stroke out towards the outside of your tree to create the tree shape.
11. Create as many trees as you want, but be sure to vary the size and height of the trees.
12. Wait for this to dry.
13. Trace the back of the pattern with your pencil. Be sure your lines are thick so that you will be able to see them when we transfer them on the canvas.
14. Place pattern over canvas, with pencil drawing down on the canvas. Rub the pattern to transfer the pencil marks onto the canvas.
15. Paint the moon with the white paint.
16. Paint the flames with a light coat of white paint.
17. Paint the marshmallow white. On your plate, mix black and white to create a light gray and paint the top and bottom oval part of the marshmallow.
18. On your plate, mix the brown and white paint to create a light brown. Paint the marshmallow sticks and the ends of the logs.
19. Paint the long part of the log with just the brown paint (no white mixed in).
20. Paint lines on the log with the light brown to create texture. Also paint a spiral on the ends of the logs. Take your paintbrush and make strokes on the "ground" to define the ground.
21. Put Red and yellow paint on your plate. Paint the bottom of your fire yellow. Make sure your brush strokes go in the direction of the flames. Wipe off your brush.
22. Paint the top half of your flames red. Be sure to blend the middle section into orange. Once this is dry, add another layer of paint.

Ribbon Rose

Supplies:

1. You will need a hot glue gun for this project (not included). Plug in the hot glue gun so that it can warm up.
2. Take your Red/Pink ribbon and wrap it around your ruler 6 full times (down one side and up the other).
3. Hold ribbon carefully and cut ends of ribbon on short ends of the ruler. This should give you 12 pieces of ribbon 3" long.
4. Make the ribbon pieces into rose petals by folding the two bottom corners up to the top edge of the ribbon. Hot glue in place.
5. Then take points and fold them into the middle and glue down on bottom.
6. Do this for all 12 pieces.
7. Take the skewer and green ribbon. Put hot glue on one end of skewer, lay ribbon flat on table and roll the ribbon around the skewer until you reach the top of the skewer. Attach with hot glue.
8. Lay out all of your rose petals, with the folded sides up. Lay each petal on top of each other, covering up one of the folded halves of the petal. Hot glue each petal in place.

INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED

9. Flip the rose petals over so the flat side is up.
10. Place hot glue on bottom straight edge of rose petals in small portions as you work so that it doesn't dry too fast.
11. Start at one end of the rose petal line. Slowly roll the skewer over the petals, making sure they are rolling around each other tightly.
12. Apply additional hot glue to end piece to hold in place.
13. You may need to pick off any excess or stringy hot glue to finish off your project.

WHY DO LEAVES CHANGE COLORS



Recipe

3 Leaves (from the same tree)

Rubbing Alcohol

Coffee Filter

Plastic Wrap

Mason Jar

Craft Stick

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Rip up leaves into tiny pieces
2. Pour rubbing alcohol over the pieces until they are just covered
3. Mash and Stir the leaves in the alcohol until it turns green (this is key)
4. Cover the jar with plastic wrap.
5. Place jar in bowl (not included). Pour hot water in the bowl around the jar.
6. Leave the jar in the water for 30-60 minutes, swishing the jar around every so often.
7. Cut a strip of coffee filter so that the filter can reach the bottom of the jar and hang out a little bit. Let this sit in there for 1 hour.
8. Take out the strip of coffee filter which should have the colors in the leaves separated out.
9. So why do leaves change colors? (Answer on the back)

Chlorophyll gives leaves their green color and is so dominant that it hides the other colors in the leaves. But in the fall, chlorophyll in the leaves breaks down, allowing other colors to finally shine through!

Did you know that you can tell how old a tree is by the rings on the inside of the tree? Look at your wooden tree cookie. Count the rings you see. How old is it? _____

2. You can tell a lot about a tree by looking at its rings. If the rings are farther apart, that means the tree grew a lot that year. If they are closer together, maybe it didn't grow as much. If there are dark splotches, that means there was something that scarred the tree.
3. Now you get to create your own tree cookie. With a pencil, draw as many rings as you are old on your cardboard tree cookie. (Ex. if you are 10, you would make 10 rings). Make sure to include any big growth years or scars. You can also include exciting things that happened (Ex - the year you got saved. Put a cross on that ring of your tree cookie).
4. Once you have your rings drawn in pencil how you like them, draw over them with a marker (not included).
5. Share your tree cookie with someone else and tell them about all of the rings and any other marks you put on there.
