1. Tonight is about Fun
2. You may collaborate with your team only!
3. Choose a Team Captain that can write well. They will be in charge of the answer sheet
4. Trivia Questions are selected by me. Answers used in the competition are the most commonly accepted answers.
5. Questions will be categorized into 5 general themes with 10 questions per category.
6. For every correct answer, the team scores 1 point. There are 10 points available per category for a total of 50 possible points per team
7. Do not worry about spelling, but you must have complete answers; no partial credit will be given. Answers must be legible to be counted
8. When the round ends, your answer sheets will be immediately collected. If you do not immediately hand over your sheet to the collector, your answers for that round will not be graded or counted
9. The judges are merely human; all decisions are final
10. Use of reference materials of any kind (cell phones, books, computers, etc) are strictly prohibited. Please keep your phones put away. If you need to make or receive a call/text, you may do so by politely leaving the room, however, if it occurs during a question session, you may not return to your table until after the round is complete.
11. On the bottom of Answer Sheet #1, each team will indicate the total number of correct answers they think their team will score in total. (out of 50) In the event of a tie, the team whose guess is the closest without going over will be the winner

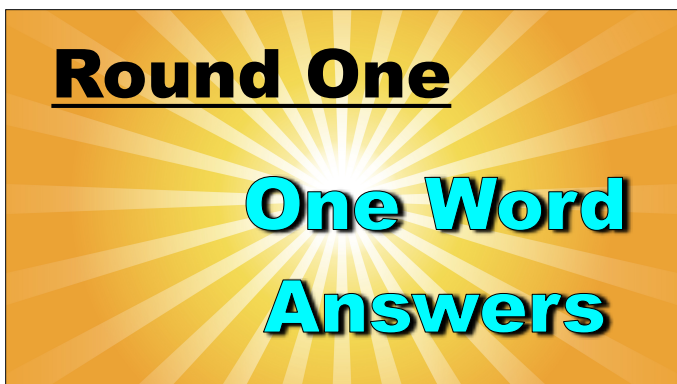
